70cm band isolator unknown source



The isolator has female N connectors at the input and output port.










Below you will find some measurement results of this isolator for the 70cm band:

S11 input matching (return loss better than 18dB, smith chart looks perfect)












S12 reverse transmission (isolation at 435 MHz is -32dB)
