Hello,


the weather was awful in the last 2 weeks so I started working on my Astro-equipment. One idea was to make use of my wooden wheely bar as an accessory tray.

I use this wheely bar to store my telescope mounted on the tripod inside my house (while being simply covered with some linen). The casters underneath the bar make it easy and quick to move the whole setup outside. As you can see in the first photograph I store the vibration suppression pads on 3 round plates I made from lids of old cans.



Once the telescope is outside I put the vibration suppression pads under the tripod and use the wheely bar as a tray for the rechargeable battery and some accessories.

To avoid people (mostly myself) stumbling over my equipment in the dark I made use of some surplus led-arrays I found in one of my drawers ;-)
